VINFAST ELECTRIC CARS EXPORTED AT TAN VU TERMINAL

Over 1,000 VinFast electric vehicles have been exported through Tan Vu Port. This milestone is significant not only for VinFast but also for Vietnam's automotive industry, showcasing the remarkable growth and global competitiveness of Vietnamese automotive brands. It also reaffirms Hai Phong Port's pioneering role in connecting and supporting manufacturer in their global expansion efforts.



On August 30th, the K'Line vessel - Bangkok Highway called to Tan Vu Terminal to export Vinfast's first shipment of electric cars to Indonesia. Over 1,000 VF34 right-hand drive vehicles were safely assembled at the port from August 27th-29th.

To ensure efficient handling and preparation for the Ro-Ro vessel operation, Tan Vu Terminal, in collaboration with K'Line and VinFast, conducted a training course on the vehicle export process. This included theoretical and practical sessions, as well as additional training on right-hand drive vehicle operation at VinFast's factory.

The successful handling of VinFast's large shipment of righthand drive electric vehicles is a testament to exceptional service at Port Of Hai Phong, marking a close collaboration between the manufacturer, the shipping line, and the Port.



DELEGATION FROM GUANGXI ZHUANG AUTONOMOUS REGION VISIT PORT OF HAI PHONG

On the morning of August 30th, a delegation from the Guangxi Zhuang Autonomous Region (China), along with the Guangxi Beibu Gulf International Port Group, visited Tan Vu terminal.

During the meeting, both sides agreed to explore and develop comprehensive cooperation based on the principle of "complementary advantages and mutually beneficial cooperation," aiming to enhance competitiveness and drive business growth for enterprises.

The delegation also expressed interest in understanding the development potential of Port Of Hai Phong and seeking investment opportunities, as well as strengthening bilateral cooperation between the Guangxi Beibu Gulf International Port Group and Port Of Hai Phong.



200 DAYS OF EFFORT – LAUNCHING BERTHS NO.3 & 4 BY FEB 28TH, 2025

On August 14th, Port Of Hai Phong launched a 200-day competition with the goal of commissioning Berths No.3 and 4 at Hai Phong International Gateway Port (Lach Huyen Port Area) into operation by February 28th, 2025.

The project, which began in July 2022, has completed 80% of the work as of early August 2024. Port Of Hai Phong is currently collaborating with equipment suppliers in Japan to install the equipment in October 2024, ensuring technical requirements, precision, and absolute safety for its operation.

With a high level of determination and relentless effort, Port Of Hai Phong aims not only to complete Phase 1 of the project before February 28th, 2025, but also to achieve full project completion by 2025.



PORT OF HAI PHONG QUICKLY RESUMES OPERATIONS AFTER TYPHOON YAGI

On September 9th, 2024, following the impact of Super Typhoon Yagi (Typhoon No. 3), operations at Hoang Dieu, Chua Ve, and Tan Vu terminals were swiftly restored. All necessary recovery measures were completed, and normal business activities resumed from 06:00 on September 9th, 2024.

Port Of Hai Phong reported no significant damage to infrastructure, equipment, or cargo. The thorough preparation and effective disaster prevention measures ensured maximum safety for port operations.
